## Certified Pool & Spa Operator (CPO) Certification Licensing Agreement

If you wish to use the CPO Certification logo on your website or business stationery, email [service@nspf.org](mailto:service@nspf.org) and request a copy. Please provide your name and CPO Certification Number. The logo **can only** be used in association with you the name of the individual who earned the certification. **It cannot be associated with a business or corporate name.**

### Proper Use of the CPO Certification Mark

When using the Certified Pool & Spa Operator (CPO) Certification mark on business documents, brochures, or a website, the word Certification must be used to follow Certified Pool & Spa Operator or CPO. For example:

- Certified Pool & Spa Operator Certification
- CPO Certification

CPO Certification is **valid for a period of five years from the date of course completion**. The expiration date will appear on your CPO Certification document. If your CPO Certification expires and you do not renew, you **MUST** remove the CPO Certification logo from your documents and website.

## Health Officials: Help Us Serve You Better!

In the subject line, please enter: **I am a health official**

In the body of your email, please include:

- Your name (as recorded on your CPO Certificate)
- Your CPO number, for example: CPO-123456
- Your government role, for example: Health Official, Parks & Recreation Director, etc.
- The name and address of your government office
- The scope of your organization, such as provincial, state, county, city, etc.

## Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

A **Continuing Education Unit** (CEU) is a measure in continuing education programs in order for a professional to maintain his/her license or credentials, especially those required in a licensed profession. Depending upon the authorizing body (examples: IACET, the Florida CILB, California Department of Public Health, HEHA, etc.), a CEU is defined as the number of hours of participation in a recognized continuing education program with qualified instruction and sponsorship. The training programs provided by the Pool & Hot Tub Alliance, whether online or in classrooms, meet these qualifications. In the body of your email, please include:

- Your name (as recorded on your CPO Certificate)
- Your CPO number, for example: CPO-123456

As a graduate of the CPO Certification program, the Pool & Hot Tub Alliance ("PHTA") grants to you a limited, non-exclusive license to use its Certified Pool & Spa Operator Certification name and/or logo (the "PHTA" Marks), solely in connection with the promotion of your status as having the Certified Pool & Spa Operator Certification. Any use of the PHTA Marks that does not conform to any PHTA Mark requirements, cheating, or actions or inactions that create a safety or health hazard shall be grounds for termination of the license and certification. This license shall automatically terminate when certification expires. All uses of the PHTA Marks shall inure to the benefit of the PHTA. **By signing the Certified Pool & Spa Operator (CPO) Certification Examination, you acknowledged and agreed to these terms and the complete terms as outlined at [nspf.org](http://nspf.org).**
